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FY 2022 Annual Report

On 12th May 2022, Xero Limited (XRO) announced its FY2022 Annual Report with the following highlights:

Financial Highlights:

- Operating revenue \$1,096.8 up 29% YoY;
- Subscribers 3.271m up 530,000 YoY;
- Annualised monthly recurring revenue \$1,231.1m up 28% YoY;
- Total subscriber lifetime value \$10.9b up 3.3b YoY;
- Gross margin percentage 87.3% up 1.3pp YoY;
- Free cash flow \$2.1m down \$54.9m YoY;
- EBITDA of \$212.7 million up \$21.4m YoY
- Reported NPAT of \$(9.1)m down \$27.5m YoY;
- Adjusted NPAT of \$(8.3)m down \$26.9m YoY;
- Reported EPS of (5.5)¢ down 18.3¢ YoY.

Market highlights

- Australia
 - Revenue was up 26% (27% in constant currency (CC)) to \$483.3m;
 - 229,000 net subscriber additions in FY22 to reach 1.34m subscribers.

UK

- Revenue increased by 30% (30% in CC) to \$291.6m;
- 130,000 net subscriber additions in FY22 to reach 850,000 subscribers.

New Zealand

- Revenue increased by 15% to \$149.4m;
- 66,000 net subscriber additions in FY22 to reach 512,000 subscribers.

North America

- Revenue increased by 28% (31% in CC) to \$72.6m;
- 54,000 net subscriber additions in FY22 to reach 339,000 subscribers.

Rest of the world

- Revenue increased by 85% (90% in CC) to \$100.0m;
- 51,000 net subscriber additions in FY22 to reach 226,000 subscribers.

Outlook

 Xero strives to continue focusing on growing its global small business platform and maintain preference for reinvesting cash generated, subject to investment criteria and market conditions, to drive long term shareholder value.

Earnings changes

XRO has reported its FY22 NPAT to be \$(9.1)m compared to market expectations of \$1.0m. Hence, we do not expect any significant earnings revision for FY23 and future periods.

Valuation

We are updating our 12-month target price from \$106.74 to \$66.96 and retaining an UNDERPERFORM recommendation. The price target is underpinned by our valuation.
